

Project organized by the “Osservatorio del Credito” in collaboration with Rome’s Tor Vergata University

In 2010, UniCredit’s compartment “**Institutional Affairs in Italy, Germany and Austria**” has supported a financial education project managed by the Osservatorio sul Credito, promoted by both the [ANSPC](#) (Associazione Nazionale per lo Studio dei Problemi del Credito) and the Faculty of Economics of the [University of Rome “Tor Vergata”](#).

The project has two objectives:

- **to raise youth awareness of financial tools and financial decision-making**
- **to promote knowledge of credit and finance** as an instrument of achieving **maturity and growth**

Thirty high schools in Rome, selected by the Regional Department for Education of Ministry of Public Education, University and Scientific Research, are participating in the project. To date, the schools have developed eight courses, taught by University researchers, focused on financial and economics topics. **The last course, taught by UniCredit colleagues, has been designed to increase young people’s understanding of banking and financial products**, and to raise their awareness of managing money and assets through the implementation of a balanced and responsible home budget.
