

Romania – General Information

PROJECT TO INTEGRATE CAPITAL MARKETS IN THE REGION CENTRAL AND SOUTH-EASTERN EUROPE

21 August 2025

The Romanian Ministry of Finance and the Bucharest Stock Exchange (BSE) are involved in a project to integrate capital markets in the region Central and South-Eastern Europe, and a Memorandum of Understanding is to be signed at the beginning of next week by a representative of the ministry, according to information sent by the Romanian Ministry of Finance.

- Attracting international investors and promoting multiple listings are among the initiative's objectives, according to the Romanian Ministry of Finance.
- A representative of the Romanian Ministry of Finance will sign a Memorandum of Understanding early next week in Zagreb (on 25 August 2025)
- Romania, Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia and North Macedonia are the countries involved in the initiative, according to the Romanian Ministry of Finance.

According to the Ministry, the main objectives of the initiative are:

- 1. Creating a common framework for cooperation between countries in the region in order to develop and integrate capital markets;
- 2. Strengthening the liquidity and attractiveness of regional markets;
- 3. Facilitating access to financing, especially for SMEs;
- 4. Attracting international investors and promoting multiple listings;
- 5. Creating a coordinated network of stock exchanges, which would be technically interdependent, but would function as independent markets;
- 6. Sending a clear political signal regarding the commitment of the countries in the region to the development of capital markets.
