The program is open to motivated young people from **Italy** (Verona-Ferrara), **Germany** (Berlin), **Bulgaria** (Plovdiv), **Czech Republic** (Prague), **Slovakia** (Bratislava), and **Romania** (Bucharest) who meet the eligibility criteria.

PROGRAM START

The learning path, provided by Glocal Factory, starts in different waves from April 2025.

Participation is completely free, thanks to full funding from UniCredit Group.

TRAINING COURSE

- In person training: 20 hours
- Online learning: 10 hours
- On-site visits to sustainable businesses: 10 hours
- Workshops/focus groups with experts with tutoring: 30 hours
