

IX Workshop on Structural Transformation and Macroeconomic Dynamics, May 2022

The workshop on Structural Transformation and Macroeconomic Dynamics was created in 2012 with the idea of bringing together experts in the field of structural change who, at the time, did not have a dedicated conference at which to meet. Since then, the field has expanded substantially, and the workshop has been organized regularly on an almost annual basis, bringing together many of the leading experts in the field. Most of the editions have been organized in Cagliari, Sardinia, Italy, with three notable exceptions: Surrey (UK), 2012, Paris (France), 2014 and Kent (UK) 2016. This year the workshop reaches its ninth edition and is held at the University of Cagliari on 30 and 31 May 2022. Registration to attend will open soon.
