2022 Winners for Italy Regions

AGS per il Territorio, Project "Maker Lab"

- Countering school dropout through enhancing basic, logical, and transversal skills to support self-efficacy and motivation of disadvantaged adolescents; experiential learning and guidance pathways; psychological, educational, and schooling intake and accompaniment.
- Beneficiaries: 360 students 11-16 years old living in three districts of Turin, Alessandria, and Vercelli (Piedmont)
- Duration: 24 months

CEDEL - Cooperativa Sociale Educativa ELIS, Project "Cloto"

- Project aimed at second-grade classes of secondary schools to support children in difficulty, with disabilities or at high risk of dropping out, through: a multimedia workshop; workshop on soft and hard skills, aimed at creating project proposals to respond to challenges launched by local entrepreneurial realities; digital training lab for effectively preparing for a job interview; interventions by inspirational success start-ups, entrepreneurs, recent graduates within schools.
- Beneficiaries: 150 students 14-19 years old of 6 schools in Veneto and Trentino-Alto Adige
- Duration: 18 months

Consorzio Meridia, Project "Skill@ti"

- Countering school dropout and educational poverty through the activation of formal and informal learning pathways for the acquisition of soft and hard skills useful for entering the world of work. Activities: Digital Technology Campus; health promotion pathways; attentive citizenship labs.
- Beneficiaries: 300 students 13-16 years old attending 5 schools in the Bari, Barletta, and Matera province (Puglia and Basilicata)
- Duration: 24 months

Junior Achievement Italia, Project "Salvaborgo"

- Path of empowerment, re-motivation, and orientation through entrepreneurial education. The aim is to support young people living in isolated and highly depopulated municipalities recognising themselves as actors of social change for the regeneration of their territories. Through hands-on and interactive experiences, students will be involved in identifying some of the challenges related to their communities, developing innovative entrepreneurial solutions.
- Beneficiaries: 150 students attending two secondary schools in the Catania and Agrigento province (Sicily)
- Duration: 24 months
